Why is Mr. Stempfer responding promptly when ODOD stonewalled Leader's public records requests?

Bob,

Thank you for sending me the current updates through September 27, 2006 concerning Leader Technologies. I appreciate your prompt response.

I understand from your e-mail that Leader has not made any payments since my last inquiry of January 11, 2006. At that time you confirmed that Leader was current with monthly payments in the amount of \$4,000.00 "...which shall be due and payable on the first day of each calendar month and delivered to the Director at the address above". I conclude that Leader has not made the monthly payment due February 1, 2006 and not made any payments to the date of my September 27, 2006 inquiry. Therefore Leader Technologies has been in default on their note for the last eight months.

"If a default occurs in the payment of any installment of principal, under this Note, continuing for a period of ten (10) days after written notice of the failure to make any such payment when due and payable, then, at the option of the Director, the entire principal sum and interest accruing at a rate of three (3) percent per annum calculated from the first date on which failure to make a payment occurs, shall become due and payable at once, without demand or notice."

There has been no written communications by either ODOD or Leader Technologies regarding failure of Leader to make the required monthly payments for eight months. ODOD has no documented evidence showing any attempt to collect this debt or to address its delinquency.

"This Agreement and its exhibits and any documents referenced to herein constitute the complete understanding of the parties and merge and supersede any and all other discussions, agreements and understandings, either oral or written, between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof."

"All notices, consents, demands, requests and other communications which may or are required to be given hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed duly given if personally delivered or sent by United States mail, registered or certified, return receipt requested, postage paid, or by a delivery service that can provide proof of mailing and receipt by both parties, to the addresses set forth hereunder or to such other address as the other party hereto may designate in written notice transmitted in accordance with this provision."

There are no written documents evidencing any changes or modifications in the Agreement, the Project, the Statement of Work, or the Cognitive Promissory Note.

Please advise me if I have misconstrued any of the above information.

I understand that this document is available as public information.
