Hi Bob,

I would like to continue to ensure that I have all the current public information available concerning Leader Technologies Incorporated. My last request for an information update was 9/22/2006 and I received documents through 9/27/2006. I want to make certain that I have any changes or other agreements that may supersede my information complete to that date. Has there been any additional correspondence between the Department of Development and Leader Technologies?

Specifically, I want to know if the Cognovit Promissory Note dated July 20, 2005 is still in effect. That document states: "Payments one through twenty-three shall each be made in the amount of Four Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$4,000.00). The final payment, due July 1, 2007, shall be in the amount of One Hundred Fifty-Eight Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$158,000)." Your last response showed that this agreement was still active and unchanged as of 9/27/2006.

I understand from my last request that Leader has not made any payments since January 2006. Are they now ten months in default on the note?

I appreciate your involvement in this matter and your responsiveness to my requests.
