
Dear Mr. Detwiler:

The Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) was received and reviewed your January 11, 2006 public records request seeking any correspondence between ODOD and Leader Technologies since August 2005. A review of our files identified only a press release concerning the company which had been forwarded to ODOD. In answer to your second concerning Leader Technologies repayment history, our records indicate that since August 1, 2005, the company has made three payments related to the July 20, 2005 note totaling \$12,000.
