Ms. Victoria D. Garry,

I am in receipt of your letter dated December 14, 2007 in response to my May 29, 2007 letter to Attorney General Marc Dann requesting public records concerning Leader Technologies Incorporated from the AG's office. To be unambiguous, this is the first reply from the AG's office specifically acknowledging my request for public records.

The request for public records from the AG's office is to determine the status of all collection activity, including the collection of the 8/27/2004 judgement against Leader by the Bureau of Worker's Compensation (attached), and to determine if any investigation concerning Leader's ODOD grant or Leader's overall activities with the State of Ohio is being conducted by the AG.

A public records request response as of 12/3/2007 from the ODOD (Robert P. Stempfer, Deputy Chief Legal Counsel) shows that NO change has occurred in the original grant agreement, the repayment agreement, or that any additional payments have been made by Leader. The debt has not been forgiven and there are no public records that would show any action by either Leader or the ODOD to address the debt repayment or modification of the debt terms and conditions.

Leader's fiscal year ends on June 30 and Leader's annual shareholder reports were issued in December 2006 for FY 2005, and December 2007 for FY 2006. There is NO mention or reference to the ODOD debt in either shareholders report. The fact that as of December 2007 Leader is over twenty-two months in arrears on their \$4,000 monthly payments, the fact that Leader did not make the \$158,000 balloon payment due July 1, 2007, or the fact that the debt was turned over to the Attorney General's Office for collection in November 2006 seems a very significant omission by Leader corporate officers of important financial information to Leader's shareholders. This also begs the question concerning the accuracy of Leader's financial information being conveyed to new potential investors. Leader either believes they do not owe the debt or they ultimately will not have to repay the debt since Leader is purposefully not disclosing the debt obligation to their shareholders.

I strongly support Attorney General Marc Dann's commitment to open government. I also strongly believe that a company accepting public funds should be willing to accept open public scrutiny in obtaining and using those funds. It was the receipt and analysis of public records that exposed Leader's blatant non-performance with regard to the terms and conditions of the grant agreement that resulted in ODOD's demand for repayment.

I look forward to your response no later than December 28, 2007.

Mr. Detwiler is forwarding to ODOD a transcript of a sanctions hearing in his lawsuit against Leader. What he failed to tell ODOD is that his attorney had presented false and misleading information to Judge Sheerhan and that Leader decided to settle rather than risk any misappropriation of its trade secrets (incl. shareholder list and customer list) which the judge had ordered without a proper protective order based upon Detwiler's attorney's false and misleading testimony.

This is my first feedback to the public records you provided me per my request of May 29, 2007 for ALL records held by the Attorney General's Office concerning Leader Technologies Incorporated.

Perhaps what was most obvious were the documents that were NOT provided that, in my opinion, would be have been public records IF the Attorney General's office did in fact have the records.

First, there were NO records provided that the AG's office has ever made any attempt to contact or collect from Leader Technologies the Bureau of Worker's Compensation Judgement dated August 24, 2004 in the amount of \$2,065. The Franklin County Court of Common Pleas shows this as still active as of this date.

Second, there is no public information that represents anything more than the information contained in the Grant Agreement that was signed by Leader corporate officers. There is no public information that evidences Leader was enticed to sign an agreement based on promises of other forthcoming monies not specified in the Grant Agreement.

Third, and now of probing importance, there were NO public records provided to me that show Leader Technologies Incorporated or Leader's legal counsel ever submitted a written request for public documents about themselves to either the ODOD or the Attorney General's Office. Mr. Donchatz testified in the Sanctions Hearing in my case (see page 34) that the ODOD and the AG both DENIED their request for public documents concerning their business relationship. It would seem to me that the next prudent action on Mr. Donchatz's part would have been to make an immediate written request to both the ODOD and the AG asking for the public documents to ensure the attempt was documented and they were making every effort to comply with court orders.

While the Attorney General's office has embarrassed itself by stumbling, fumbling, and taking eight months to respond to my May 29, 2007 request for public documents, I want to be crystal clear that the Ohio Department of Development (through Mr. Robert P. Stempfer and previously Ms. Marlo B. Tannous) has been crisp, flawless, and timely in their response to each and every request for public documents I have made. Of course, I would never know that anything was missing; however, I believe they have been thorough. It certainly mystifies me why I got public records so easily while Leader's counsel was refused the same information.

I will let the attached public record transcript of the Sanction Hearing in my lawsuit against Leader Technologies Incorporated speak for itself. It is provided in its entirety to ensure that nothing is presented out of context. I believe this will greatly enlighten the ODOD and the AG to Leader's credibility and tactics.

I think it is obvious that before the Attorney General's Office settles for thirty-two cents on the dollar on behalf of their client ODOD, proof should be demanded concerning the records and the existence (or non-existence) of critical information Leader has provided the ODOD and the Attorney General's Office supporting any of Leader's claims.
